

What Is E-Pay?

E-Pay is a free, easy to use, payment system that utilizes a new type of peer to peer money exchange called 'blockchains'. These blockchains are composed of networks of computers that all work together to send and receive little bits of information we call Electra.

What does Electra do?

Electra is worth money! It can sent to anyone be around the globe in less than a second for payments, or you can use it to buy things or sell it for regular cash.

What makes E-pay Different?

Transactions are instantaneous, so what your payment system does that already right? How about 64 seconds for transaction verification and little to no fees to boot.

Ok, you're joking right?

Not at all, Electra combined with E-Pay provides a near fee-less service to consumers as well as businesses while also offering 64 second verifications for instant transactions anywhere around the world. Fees are only paid by the sender, the receiver (you) owes nothing. Great deal right?

Fees

The fees associated with Electra E-Pay are virtually nothing, all the fees are for is to make sure the payment reaches the appropriate destination and are not collected or owned by anyone. Our minimum fee for senders is 0.00001 ECA, (ECA stands for Electra), this means it would take over 100,000 payments from a single person to rack up a cost of 1 Electra (ECA). Consumers won't even notice and your businesses will have a truly fee-less payment system.

Transaction Verification

Typical transactions are verified by the Electra network within ± 64 seconds, as opposed to your typical 24 hours for the average payment system this means you get your payments faster, and can spend them at your pace without having to wait for the dreaded 'pending transaction' to disappear.

Instant Transactions

Transaction speed from sender to receiver typically takes a few milliseconds for the network to process, you will receive payments literally within the blink of an eye.
